General Exemption E 5560

Gratuitous Carriage of Passengers and/or Cargo by Part-CAT AOC Holders

Background

- 1) The purpose of this Exemption is to discharge any holder of a Part-CAT air operator certificate from the requirement to operate a flight in accordance with public transport requirements when specific conditions are met.

Interpretation

- 2) In this Exemption, references to EU regulations are to those regulations as retained and amended in UK domestic law under the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018 and are referenced as "UK Regulation (EU) year/number" or "UK Regulation (EU) No. number/year".
- 3) Part-CAT and Part-ORO have the same meaning as provided in Schedule 1 of the Air Navigation Order 2016 ("the Order").

Exemption

- 4) The Civil Aviation Authority, in exercise of its powers under article 266 of the Order, exempts any holder of a Part-CAT air operator certificate from any requirement in the Order to operate a flight in accordance with public transport requirements that would apply to the holder if the only reason that the flight is a public transport flight is because all passengers or cargo on board the aircraft are carried gratuitously in the aircraft, by virtue of article 6(2)(b)(ii) of the Order.
- 5) A flight pursuant to this Exemption must be operated in accordance with UK Regulation (EU) No. 965/2012, ORO.AOC.125(a).
- 6) This Exemption supersedes Official Record Series 4 No.1432, which is revoked.

Date in Force

- 7) This Exemption has effect from the date it is signed until 31 October 2022, both dates inclusive, unless previously revoked.
